Requirements & Expectations of Participants

Requirements

- Candidates should be deeply committed to the Christian Faith
- Be active and serving in the local church
- 25-40 years old
- Committed to their City
- Show leadership qualities in their vocational field and community

COST: 20,000 Ksh (200 USD)

Expectations: During Cohort

Twice a month commitment which includes:

- Monthly cohort gatherings
- Mentoring sessions
- Optional Attend Global Cohort Gathering (GCG) Retreat in the US

Expectations: After Cohort

- Commit to and be accountable to individualized action plan
- Continue to engage in vocation, church and city for the sake of the Gospel
- Optional volunteer in the Resource Global alumni network as an advocate, mentor, or even future teacher.

Q & A

What are the cohorts?

Our cohort is a 9-month Gospel-Centered Leadership Training Community that wants to further engage in their faith through their workplaces, communities and cities. We bring high-capacity individuals from diverse backgrounds to grow in their understanding of how the Gospel calls them and equips them to take Gospel action steps in their lives. And our goal is to do this in a community of 12-15, developing and equipping local leadership for the longevity and health of the global church.

What is our Curriculum?

Our curriculum is focused on themes like identity, work, and mission, while also focusing on city-specific areas that are modified for each of our cities. For example, our Jakarta cohort focuses on family businesses or living in a majority Muslim context while our Chicago cohort focuses on racism and segregation, and division in the church. In Nairobi, we look at challenges facing Christians in the marketplace (e.g., corruption, maintaining high standards, and finding/keeping talent).

What is our Mentorship Program?

Our Mentorship is pairing each leader with an older, more experienced mentor in a similar field of work. They meet once a month, share life, share problems, and challenge one another how to live out their faith in the various areas of life. The gift of mentorship is that it not only benefits the mentee, but also benefits the mentor who can pour their lives into others while being challenged themselves.

What kind of teaching do we have?

Our Teaching comes from various church, workplaces, and community leaders in the West and those in other global cities. They bring in their expertise, experience, and wisdom on how to guide future leaders on various questions and tasks they will face ahead. Because we are a global network, we offer them in both in-person formats and online video formats to cross pollinate our teaching.

What is our Global Cohort Gathering (GCG)?

Our Global Cohort Gathering (GCG) is an opportunity to bring all our cohorts from around the world together to further the cross pollinating learning and networking. We bring in key speakers and encourage further dialogue on how each city and cohort member can make a difference in their cities with the power of the Gospel.
